Getting to higher and lower ground



Lets review the mobile and stationary surfaces designed for ascending, lateral and descending foot traffic. Some of such surfaces -staircases as an example- have been around for centuries; though others are relatively recent developments. Mobile surfaces such as elevators and escalators are surfaces that most of us residing in urban an suburban areas take for granted.



This could not be more obvious during a power outage. People dependent on vertical transportation who's traversed flights of stairs during a power outage -or whenever the power stalls an elevator- are reminded of such dependence. Without power, only stairs are available for building occupants to bridge these larger vertical distances with smaller vertical distances; one step at a time.
