
#### **CDC Study**



The CDC found a high level of the coronavirus on the floors and shoes of medical staff at a Chinese hospital that deals with COVID-19 patients, according to an early release of a CDC <u>study</u>.



What were the findings? 94% of swabs taken from the ICU floor and 100% of swabs taken from one of the general wards used to treat patients with severe symptoms tested positive. Notably, the shoe soles of the ICU medical staff were tested. The results? 50% tested positive.





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
