Before they were renamed floorcloths, they were called area canvas rugs. They made their debut within wealthy European circles. It was specifically in England at some point during the 18th century. Their designs and patterns were an attempt to imitate marble, wood and tile floors.



These furnishings proved useful with the passing of time and were eventually affordably priced for middle-class families. It was at this time that there was an increase in the variety of patterns of area canvas rugs. After the American colonists were liberated from England, the area canvas rug market rapidly expanded beyond England's
