The <u>usage share</u> is an accurate and reliable statistical method for measuring the popularity of a particular website browser and, through its share of usage, the popularity of one website browser could be compared with its competitors.



It is believed to be a more accurate and reliable method of measurment. Why? Measuring browser usage in the number of requests, or the number of hits made by each user agent, could actually be a misleading method of statistical measurment. How so? Not all page requests are generated by users and user agents may make requests at regular time intervals without user input. So its possible this method might overestimate the user's activity!
